

Marquette Coaches & Camp Directors



Meredith Black was named the first head coach in Women's Lacrosse history on Feb. 4, 2011. Coach Black arrived at Marquette after spending seven years as an assistant coach at Towson University, University of Notre Dame and University of

California-Berkeley. Black helped Towson and Notre Dame to a combined 4 NCAA Championship Appearances. As a player, Black was named IWLCA 1st Team All-American and Big East Co-Attack Player of the Year in 2004, among other honors.



Caitlin Fifield came to Marquette in 2015 following an impressive playing career at the University of Richmond and two seasons as assistant coach at Wagner College. Fifield played attack at the University of Richmond and capped off her career with one of

the school's top single seasons in program history. In 2009, she was a member of the Canadian National Team. Fifield is the offensive and recruiting coordinator at MU.



Biz Goslee returned to Marquette and joined the staff in 2017 following a decorated four-year career in which she started all 68 games and left as the all-time leader in caused turnovers. In 2014, Goslee trained with the US team in the Champions

Challenge. Biz is the defensive coordinator at MU.
